Purchase of Textbooks for the 2011 Academic Year

Attached to this letter is a list of books that your son will require for 2011. Some of the required books will be supplied by the school via the Departmental allocation for textbooks, but this allocation has been cut substantially, so the school has been able to purchase very few new books. Also, we have not been given any funding from the department to replace books which have been in use for several years now, and are in poor condition. The onus will thus be on you, as parents, to ensure that your sons have the books on this list.


New books can be ordered through **Bookworld** at **Cascades** shopping centre (Tel 033-3471361), who do the school's textbook order and who have a copy of our requirements. They have given us extremely efficient service in the past. If you identify yourself as a College parent, you will be eligible for a discount in several instances.

As previously mentioned, the school does receive a textbook allocation from the Education Department, and as a result of this a number of textbooks were supplied to pupils **ON LOAN** for the past year. These books will need to be returned to the subject teachers **in an acceptable condition on the day that the last paper in that particular subject is being written**. This is particularly important information for you as parents, as any books that your son does not return at this time will be charged to your account!

The books marked with a double asterisk (**) on the list are books that boys have been asked to buy in the past, so your sons may be able to buy them second-hand from a boy in a higher form, but this will have to be done on a one-to-one basis, as the school is not able to man a second-hand bookshop.
